Compare and contrast what might happen if it were announced that two new landfills were going to be built in Wake County: one near Green Hope High School and one in downtown Raleigh, near Rock Quarry Rd and Martin Luther King Blvd. Use [THIS MAP](#) and then zoom into Wake County to examine the socioeconomic indicators and then click on the various indices before writing your 2-3 sentence response.

14. Using the same map as in #13, find the location of the site you chose in the Jigsaw Activity above. Investigate each of the indices on the left side of the map (enviro justice, supplemental indices, pollution & sources, socioeconomic indicators, health disparities, critical service gaps) and write a statement about EACH of the six indices for that area as compared to the greater surrounding area.
