Papers may be resubmitted up until the due date should you discover errors or a high plagiarism score. At a minimum, papers should address the following topics in addition to having a work cited page;

- 1. Taxonomy and Major Species of the Family
- 2. Locations Found and Environment Preferred
- 3. Significant Adaptations and Characteristics
- 4. Population Threats (to the specific family and/or to the ecosystem)
- 5. Conservation Efforts (to the specific family or to the ecosystem)
